Apprentices will also support with ground level running of shows such as front of house, social media marketing, supporting the Bradford Producer and shadowing the Stage Manager, Artistic Directors, Bradford Producer.

Job Description:

- Work closely with the Co-Artistic Director and Bradford Producer to conceive, develop and deliver a programme of events at Speakers Corner
- Collaborate with other local young people to ensure events are relevant to the concerns and passions of other young people in Bradford
- Support in the promotion of events to encourage young people and community members to join Speakers Corner and to experience Common Wealth shows as audience and participants
- Assist on theatre productions with Front of House and Social Media promotion
- Work with Common Wealth and the local community to maintain existing strategical relationships and develop new relationships.

- Monitor and track expenditure within agreed budgets
