

LIGHTING ENGINEER / OPERATOR



Job Description

The Lighting Engineer will work closely with the Lighting Designer to ensure the lighting requirements of the show are fully supported. They will be responsible for ensuring the show is rigged accurately, and for the programming and running of the show lighting. Responsibilities will include:

- Gaining a good understanding of the lighting requirements of the show and working with the Production Manager to ensure the system is specified to achieve this
- Leading the lighting install during build
- Programming the show
- Operating lighting for the show, called by the Company Stage Manager
- Identifying and performing any maintenance to the lighting system, supported by the Technical Stage Manager
- Following pre-show checks and reporting any issues
