Job Description

The Video Engineer will work closely with the Live Cinema Director and Video Designer to ensure the video requirements of the show are fully supported. They will be responsible for ensuring the video system covers the creative requirements of the show, and that video cues are programmed accurately. Responsibilities will include:

- Gaining a good understanding of the video requirements of the show and working with the Production Manager to ensure the system is specified to achieve this
- Leading the video install during build
- Working with the Technical Stage Manager and Production Assistants to ensure any camera operation is covered
- Making changes to the show QLab during technical rehearsals
- Operating video for the show, called by the Company Stage Manager
- Working with the Live Cinema Director to record, edit and broadcast a live captured film
- Identifying and performing any maintenance to the video system, supported by the Technical Stage Manager
- Following pre-show checks and reporting any issues
