WHAT WILL THE WORKSHOPS BE LIKE?

Six practical sessions over one year led by industry professionals including: acting, movement, devising, writing, film/projection and music.

Workshops are held at Common Space and will last two hours including social time to get to know the group and facilitators. From January 2026 we will hire space in the city center for the workshops.

DO I HAVE TO DO ALL OF THE WORKSHOPS?

No. We will have 15-20 spaces per session. You will sign up for what you are interested in. If something is oversubscribed, we will run a ballot to offer places.

WHAT IS THE COMMITMENT?

The Collective will run for one year and we would expect you to come to at least three workshops. You'll also join our WhatsApp group, stay in the loop about other opportunities, and have access to free rehearsal space *until we move buildings in December 2025.

HOW WILL YOU SELECT MEMBERS?

We are building a Collective that includes a range of ages, backgrounds, experience and interests. We'll also prioritise people who demonstrate how they will benefit from the opportunity.



DO YOU COVER COSTS?

Yes. We can cover public transport across Bradford. If you have any access needs — just let us know. We aim to meet all reasonable adjustments and requirements in order to support you to attend.
